

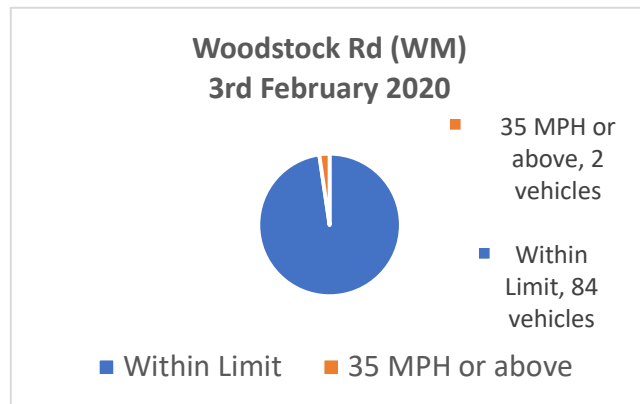
# Stonesfield Parish Council SAFER Report March 2010



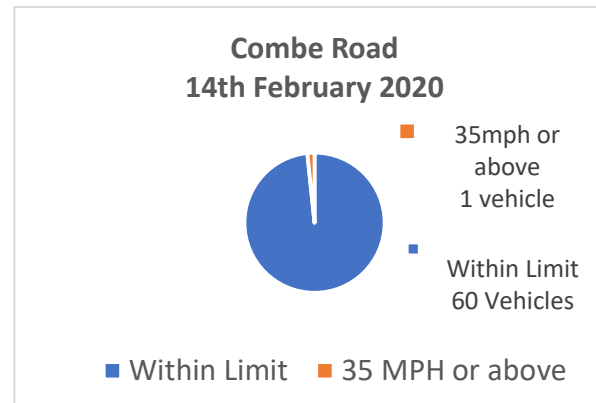
## Headlines

- Since the SAFER team were trained on the new Morelock SID 4 Community Speed Watch surveys have been undertaken. The survey scheduled for 20<sup>th</sup> of February was abandoned due to adverse weather conditions.
- Charts for the surveys completed this period are shown below and represent the format for reporting all surveys in future.
- A SAFER team meeting was held on 28<sup>th</sup> February. Changes to the Risk Assessment and other procedures were agreed.
- Another Stonesfield resident has shown an interest in joining the SAFER team.
- Various road and speed watch signs suffered in the high winds and have been replaced or fixed via 'Fix My Street'.
- The SID data is based on 'radar hits' meaning a vehicle can be represented by several hits. Manual data recording by the SAFER team ensures the quality of the data is reassured and that vehicle counts remain as accurate as possible.
- Stonesfield residents continue to thank the SAFER team when they are running CSW surveys.
- The SAFER team continue to liaise with WODC & OCC to improve signage and road markings in the village.

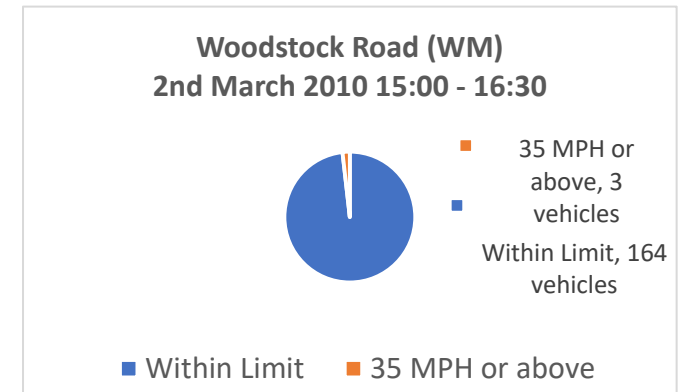
