## Subject Matter:

Attended and spoke at OCC Cabinet about the consequences and impact of the Traffic Order banning HGV at Burford Bridge and the need for more reliable data counting to be done before the final decision to be taken in January ? February 2022.

Work by the Windrush Valley Traffic Action Group highlighted their extensive work and the common agreement that more work needed to be done cross counties to establish better routings. Leader of the council acknowledged the impact of the ban on Woodstock too.
