

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(STONESFIELD) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20\*\***

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order - due to road safety concerns raised by local residents & the Parish Council - is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** throughout Stonesfield village replacing the existing 30mph speed limit in its entirety.

Also, priority will be given to vehicles travelling northwards through the village on Laughton Hill/The Ridings at the junction with Boot Street. Signage will show that vehicles travelling south will have to Give Way to oncoming vehicles.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Stonesfield) (30 Miles per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012 will be revoked.
