## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STONESFIELD) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 20\*\*

### STATEMENT OF REASONS

Oxfordshire County Council is proposing to introduce a 20mph speed limit throughout Stonesfield village. The proposals are being put forward following road safety concerns raised by local residents & the Parish Council. Extensive local engagement has been carried out, along with speed limit surveys at key points on the network in the area.

The measures will see a reduction of the existing 30mph speed limit to 20mph on all roads within the village. A give-way/priority traffic calming feature will also be introduced on Laughton Hill/The Ridings, with traffic travelling northwards having right of way.

The County Council continues its responsibility to consider the provision of convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised whilst facilitating the effective and safe passage of traffic.
