OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (STONESFIELD) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20**

The Oxfordshire County Council ("the Council) in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 & 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order.

- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour in any of the roads specified in the schedule to this order.
- No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
- 4. The Oxfordshire County Council (Stonesfield) (30 Miles Per Hour Speed Limit) Order 2012 is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

The whole length of every road in Stonesfield extending (in the case of the respective roads leading out of the village) to the following points:

a)	Combe Road	263 metres southeast of its junction with Woodstock Road.
b)	Laughton Hill	86 metres southwest of its junction with Witney Lane.
c)	Stonesfield Riding	144 metres northeast of its junction with Farley Lane.
d)	Witney Lane	100 metres southwest of its junction with Laughton Hill.
e)	Woodstock Road	287 metres northeast of its junction with Greenfield Road.
