# 22/463 To receive reports from District or County Councillors and Parish councillor reports

Cllr Andy Graham

(22/463.01) Bus services are going to be retained as is – initially for the first six months since April. (22/463/02) Capacity is down so this service really needs to be used in order to keep this service past the six months.

(22/463.03) Oxford is one of the first cities in the UK to have approx. 100 electric buses – this is great news. There is going to be a bus lane introduced south of Woodstock to fast track buses in to Oxford. The clerk asked if Cllr Graham could share any transport plans with the parish.

(22/463.04) Pavement outside of shop needs to be dropped; the clerk asked Andy Graham if he can assist with pushing this and ascertaining an OCC site visit.

(22/463/05) Cllr Andy Graham will circulate his council report and the clerk will share it with councillors.

## 22/464 Queens Jubilee / Canopy

(22/464.01) Suggestion of circular Jubilee walk around the village 2 or 3.5 miles with benches / information plaques (perhaps QR codes) placed at various points around the village. There is a jubilee committee that met with the Village Hall who have lots of ideas.

The council RESOLVED to permit 3 fruit trees on Longore. The council agreed to pay 50% of the cost of the trees.

Request that we remember the Heros of the village – this could go on the website with detail and info. Cllr Andy Graham suggested Oxfordshire Museum having an updated exhibition.
