



Q2 Which of the following best describes your home in Stonesfield?





Q3 Do you (or your household) rent or own your home?





Q4 How many bedrooms does your home have?





Q5 How many live in your home, including yourself?












Q9 Does your home have any of the following sources of green energy? Tick all relevant boxes.







Q12 Where do your school age children go to school? Tick all boxes that apply.





Q13 How do your primary age children usually get to pre-school and/or primary school? Tick all boxes that apply.





Q14 How do your secondary age children usually get to secondary school? Tick all boxes that apply.





Q15 How many people in your household attend further or higher education (post secondary school)? Specify number.





Q16 If anyone has left your household in the last five years, why did they leave? Tick all boxes that apply.












Q21 How many bedrooms will you be/are you looking for in your next home? Tick one box.




